#### **Draco Roffensis project**

We are honoured to have been able to take part in the upcoming art installation that will be on display in Rochester Cathedral. Each pupil was given a foil dragon scale to emboss with a design of their choice. There were some lovely unique and creative designs! The children had lots of fun and learned about the Textus Roffensis (Latin for "Rochester Book") which is a twelfth century book that contains laws, charters, genealogies and other documents related to the Cathedral Church of Rochester. 
